CRPA is moving forward with a lawsuit against the sheriff of San Diego County for failing to issue CCW, a judge involved in the case was said to have denied the CRPA brief regarding the 'open carry' law that a person could load their weapon in time to save themselves.

Current legislation banning open carry could bolster the CRPA argument for issuance of CCW permits.
