## TSA STEEL SERVICE RIFLE COMPETITION GUIDELINES

### TSA SERVICE RIFLE REQUIREMENTS

#### RIFLE REQUIREMENTS

Any government issue service rifle

Must not exceed caliber allowed by current range rules ( no .50 cal.)

Must have iron sights, no optics allowed

#### COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

You will be shooting 10 rounds at 10 separate steel targets at various distances ranging from approximately 75 yards to approximately 325 yards, in 3 different shooting positions. Starting with OFFHAND, then SITTING or KNEELING, and finally PRONE. You may choose any less stable firing position at any time. Finally you will be shooting 5 rounds at 500 yards from any of the shooting positions listed above. At this point if you shoot a magazine fed rifle you will be required to make 1 magazine change in each in each of the 3 shooting positions, this is to make the competition more fair for bolt action and M1 Garand shooters if the competition is being timed.
