TSA STEEL SERVICE RIFLE AND CENTERFIRE HANDGUN COMPETITION GUIDELINES

TSA SERVICE RIFLE REQUIREMENTS RIFLE REQUIREMENTS

Any government issue service rifle

Must not exceed caliber allowed by current range rules (no .50 cal.)

Must have iron sights, no optics allowed

All Federal, State, local, and range rules must be obeyed

All rifles shall be used in the manner they were designed (ie: all magazine fed rifles must use a magazine, no single loading unless approved by the match coordinator.)

AMMUNITION REQUIREMENTS

NO steel core or penetrator ammunition will be allowed on the range at anytime

All ammunition will be subject to inspection at any time

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

In this competition you will be shooting 10 rounds at 10 separate steel targets at various distances ranging from approximately 75 meters to approximately 325 meters, in 3 different shooting positions. Starting with OFFHAND, then SITTING or KNEELING, and finally PRONE. You may choose any less stable firing position at any time. Finally you will be shooting 5 rounds at 500 meters from any of the shooting positions listed above. This event will be timed in case of tied scores.

TSA CENTERFIRE HANDGUN REQUIREMENTS

HANDGUN REQUIREMENTS

Any centerfire revolver or semi automatic ranging from .25 to .45 caliber

Must be equipped with iron sights no optics allowed

Must have standard configuration barrel (no special configuration target Barrels, ie: bull barrels, etc.)

All Federal, State, local, and range rules must be obeyed at all times

All handguns must be operated in a safe manner in which they were Designed

AMMUNITION REQUIREMENTS

**Due to range safety concerns NO Magnum loads will be allowed
No steel core or penetrator ammunition will be allowed on the range
at any time**

All ammunition will be subject to inspection at any time

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

In this competition you will be shooting at 2 sets of 5 targets at various distances ranging from 10 yards to 30 yards. You will start by shooting 5 rounds at the first set of targets, then reload and shoot 5 rounds at the second set of targets. We will do this in three rounds in accordance with the service rifle competition. Finally you will be shooting 5 rounds at 100 yards.

This competition will be taking place at the same time as the service rifle competition. Handgun shooters will be coordinated to shoot during the slack time between service rifle shooters. This event will be timed in case of a tied score.

All TSA scheduled competitions are open to the PUBLIC.
